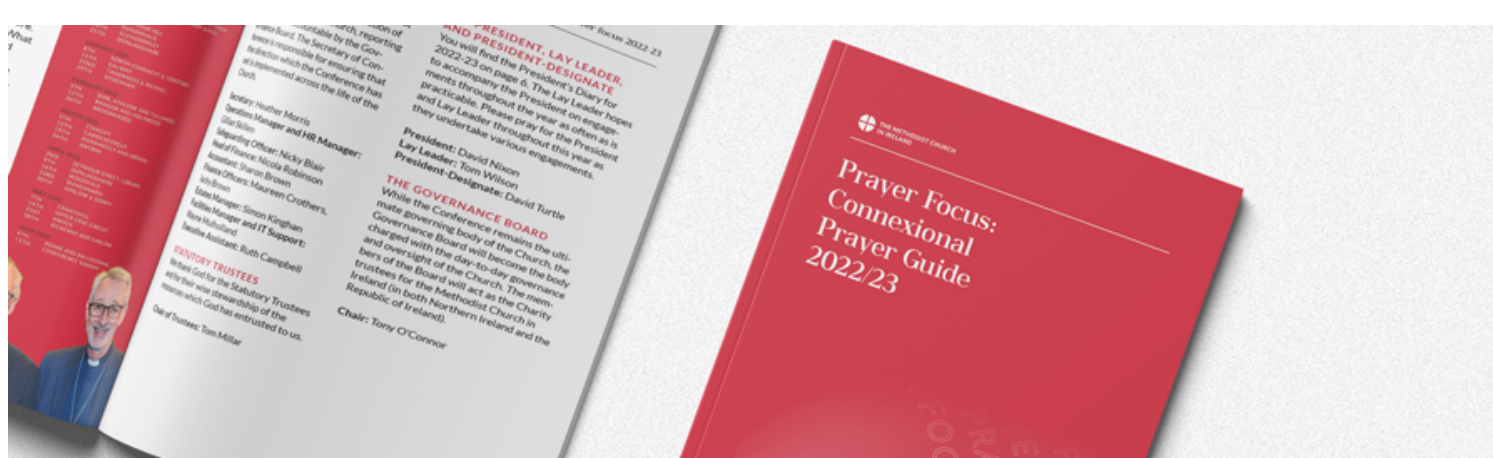
April Shopping List
