Prayer Ministry will be available between the Services.

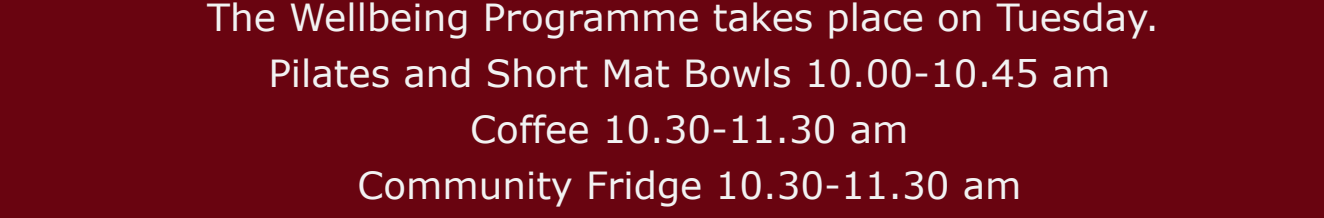
BUILDING WORK AT CHURCH



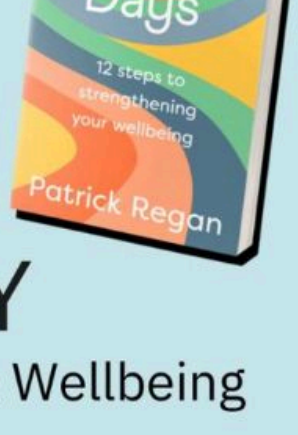

Hosted by Patrick Regan OBE, founder of Brighter Days and Kintsugi Hope.

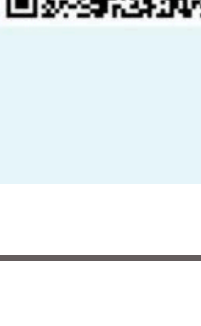

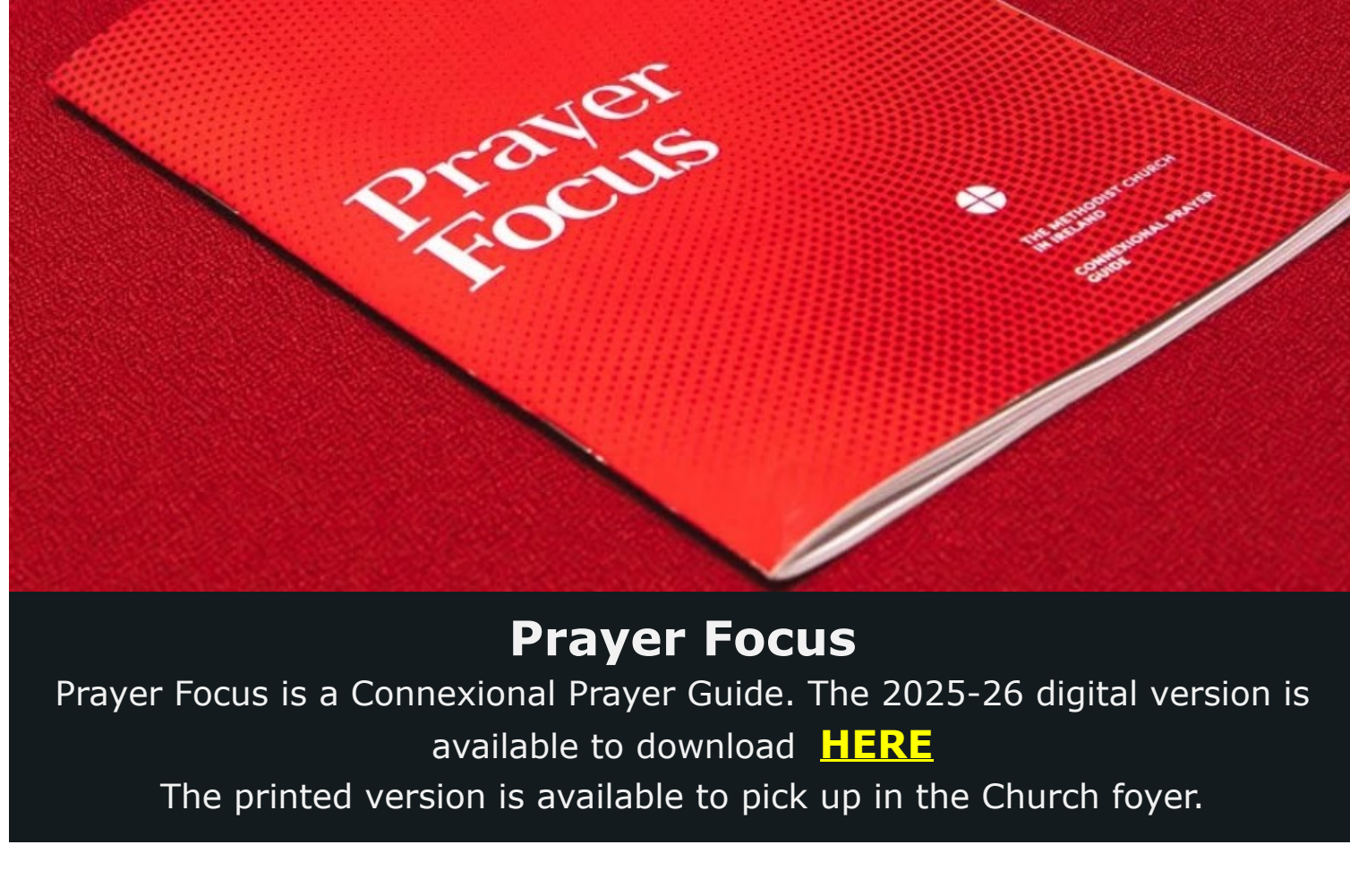

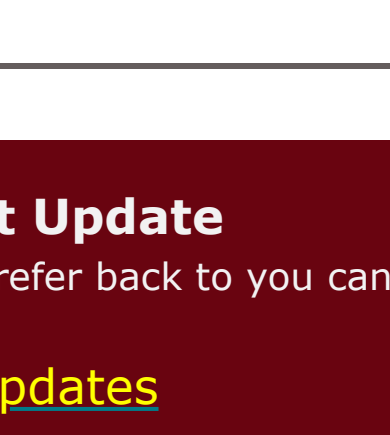
